Training Expectations

1) For clients new to Love Notes:

Phase 1 –

- *Year 1-Three-day training for all instructional and project staff*
- *Before or early in Year 2 – two day refresher/ booster training with advanced facilitation professional development training*

Phase 2 –

- *Year 3-Three-day training for all instructional and project staff*
- *Before or early in Year 4 –two day refresher/ booster training/implementation self-assessment*

2) Clients who have been trained in Love Notes Classic/EBP and are new to Love Notes SRA/EBP:

Phase 1 –

- *Year 1-Two-day training for all instructional and project staff*
- *Before or early in Year 2 – two day refresher/ booster training with advanced facilitation professional development training*

Phase 2 –

- *Year 3-Two-day training for all instructional and project staff*
- *Before or early in Year 4 –two day refresher/ booster training/implementation self-assessment*
